#### BOOTH # 101

Sinclair Community College

Faculty Development in Hybrid and Advance Automotive Technology

This project is designed to train college and high school instructors on hybrid/alternative fuel vehicle systems through a train-the-trainer approach. The safety and technological changes evolving with the electric vehicle industry require new strategies for their diagnosis and service. This project is also designed to devolop resources and curriculum content.

#### BOOTH # 102

Valencia College

Closing the Gap: Designing and Implementing a Cybersecurity Program

This showcase will focus on some of the key design principles for establishing a successful cybersecurity program. Strategies to be shared include curriculum and program development issues; alaboratory environment design and accessibility challenges; and creative ways to build industry and community partnerships.

Bergen Community College

A Quality Assurance Training Program for Biological and Chemical Science Technicians

The Quality Assurance for the Life Science Industries Program trains students in the adherence to the regulations that are required for working in the pharmaceutical, chemical, personal care, and other regulated businesses in metropolitan New York and New Jersey. In this workforce development program, emphasis is placed on developing transferable skills.

TIME—a collaborative effort among Mississippi State University's Center for Science, Mathematics, and Technology; East Mississippi Community College; and Itawamba Community College—provides a model to unite education and industry while producing qualified technicians for the high tech fields driving the state and national economy.

A Regional Photonics Initiative at the College of Lake County is providing the Greater Chicago Metropolitan area with professionals who use light and lasers in a safe and careful environment. These highly sought technicians are employed in companies, educational institutions, and government positions throughout Northern Illinois region.

#### ROOTH # 106

Hagerstown Community College Building a Pathway in Biotechnology: From Vision to Reality

Pathway implementation involves partnerships, effort, and persistence. Success includes mathematics interventions, secondary teacher buy-in, recruitment efforts in diverse populations, skills assessment, current equipment, and oncampus internships that utilize external agency contracts with wide-range discipline relevance. This showcase will feature best practices in developing a career pathway for biotechnology.

#### BOOTH # 201

Western Kentucky University Water Training Institute

The Water Training Institute builds on existing linkages with the water and wastewater employment sector (public and private utilities/ municipalities), state primacy agencies, and technical assistance/trade associations to refine an industry needs-driven curriculum that utilizes online course delivery to provide options for both traditional and nontraditional students.

#### ROOTH # 202

Sinclair Community College Dayton Urban STEM Academy

In this STEM teacher development iniative, high school students are encouraged to pursue urban teaching careers by the creation of a STEM teacher pipeline with appropriate articulation agreements, and to develop a teacher education paradigm that uses an inquiry-based pedagagical framework to effectively teach STEM content.

Synergy is creating a national network of expertise focused on tools, practices, and processes of scale. A program of professional growth, team development, and knowledge management using Synergy methodologies is helping to develop the skills and competencies necessary to achieve scale within a broad range of projects and initiatives in the ATE program.

Solar Energy Technology Project
